WHAT

What does the Bible say?

¹⁸Then Jesus came to them and said, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

Matthew 28:18-20

When Jesus commanded His followers to make disciples, what did He mean by that?

- **Seek lost people.**

When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.

Matthew 9:36

Making disciples does not start at looking for believers so we can teach them to become better Christians. Discipleship starts at reaching out to people who do not know God yet and leading them to have a relationship with Jesus (Luke 19:10; Matthew 9:10-13).

- **Set an example.**

Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ.

1 Corinthians 11:1

Our platform to speak the truth comes from a lifestyle of godliness and integrity. If we want people to listen to us, we have to set an example of our faith and moral values (1 Timothy 4:12).

- **Share your faith.**

Preach the Word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage—with great patience and careful instruction.

2 Timothy 4:2

Making disciples means showing people how to follow Jesus and obey His teachings. We share our faith by being ready, confident, and knowledgeable of the message that comes from God's Word (Romans 1:16; Philemon 6).
