WHAT

What does the Bible say?

The Bible clearly says that Jesus is coming again and gives some signs that are telling of the end of age. However, only God the Father knows when Jesus will return (Matthew 24). In response to this, many have tried to predict when and others have panicked and prepared on their own. But as Christians, what should our response be to this much-awaited event of Jesus' return?

## Think and plan long-term but live as if Jesus is coming tomorrow.

<sup>4</sup>But you, brothers, are not in darkness so that this day should surprise you like a thief. <sup>5</sup>You are all sons of the light and sons of the day. We do not belong to the night or to the darkness. <sup>6</sup>So then, let us not be like others, who are asleep, but let us be alert and self-controlled.

1 Thessalonians 5:4-6

Since we are assured of God's salvation, the exact date of Christ's return should not bother us and stop us in accomplishing the tasks that God has called us to do. Whether Jesus is returning next week, next month, or next year, God's Word encourages us to always be alert and self-controlled. How do we continue moving forward with our plans and goals at the same time live with the urgency that Jesus is coming soon?

## · Continue to honor God and make disciples.

<sup>419</sup>Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup>and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

Matthew 28:19,20
