### WORD

*<sup>1</sup>When the day of Pentecost arrived, they were all together in one place. <sup>2</sup>And suddenly there came from heaven a sound like a mighty rushing wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. <sup>3</sup>And divided tongues as of fire appeared to them and rested on each one of them. <sup>4</sup>And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance. **ACTS 2:1-4***

When the Holy Spirit came upon the disciples at Pentecost, each of them were filled with the Spirit, and this manifested in the disciples speaking in many different tongues. The division that happened as a result of man's disobedience to fill the earth in Genesis 11 was reversed in Acts 2 when the Holy Spirit came and gave the disciples the supernatural ability to communicate in different languages. The Holy Spirit was at work then, and He is still at work now. In this lesson, we will see how the Holy Spirit gives us the same power, the same mission, and the same message, even today.

## 1 The Same Power

*<sup>16</sup>“But this is what was uttered through the prophet Joel: <sup>17</sup>“And in the last days it shall be, God declares, that I will pour out my Spirit on all flesh, and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams . . .”* **ACTS 2:16,17**

The same Holy Spirit that empowered the disciples to preach boldly so many years ago is the same Holy Spirit that empowers us to go and make disciples of all nations today. God has called us to be His witnesses (Acts 1:8) wherever we are and wherever we will go. Recall a time when the Holy Spirit empowered you to boldly preach the gospel to a family member, friend, or stranger. What happened?

## 2 The Same Message

*And Peter said to them, “Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.”* **ACTS 2:38**

The gospel is for every person of every culture in every nation and in every time period. We make use of different methods to engage our culture and community to tell others about what Jesus has done for us—His sinless life, perfect death, and powerful resurrection. ## 3 The Same Mission

*“For the promise is for you and for your children and for all who are far off, everyone whom the Lord our God calls to himself.”*

**ACTS 2:39**

(Read also **MATTHEW 28:19,20.**)

The Great Commission—to *go and make disciples of all nations* (Matthew 28:19)—was not only given to the apostles, but also to us, by the same power of the Holy Spirit. Since God’s intent is to *fill the earth and subdue it* (Genesis 1:28), we are not to stop preaching the same message of the gospel until all of the world knows and believes in Him. What does Jesus promise us as we participate in His mission? (Matthew 28:20)
