



## 1 | We reflect God's glory.

*Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness. And let them have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the heavens and over the livestock and over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."*

**GENESIS 1:26**

Being made in the image of God means that He is seen in us and that we reflect His glory. This does not mean that our physical bodies reflect the literal image of God. It does mean, however, that we reflect the likeness of God through our ability to think, reason, create, and exercise dominion over creation, which He has called us to take care of. He set us apart from creation as His masterpiece, breathing into us His breath of life. How should we treat one another, knowing that we reflect God's glory?

## 2 | We are meant to live in community.

*Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness. . . ."* **GENESIS 1:26**

From the very beginning, we are being introduced to God as a relational being—the Father, Son, and Spirit living in perfect harmony as they created the world. We who are made in His image are meant to live harmoniously in community with others. We reflect His image together, not just as individuals (Romans 12:5). As we live in a healthy community, we can more effectively accomplish God's command together. Which community are you part of? How is your community helping you pursue God's purpose for your life?

## 3 | We are highly valued.

*"Whoever sheds the blood of man, by man shall his blood be shed, for God made man in his own image."* **GENESIS 9:6**

Since we are made in God's image, we have value. And this value is not based on our achievements, wealth, track record, or skills. Our value as bearers of the image of God cannot be earned or taken away. God doesn't even want us to be harmed in any way, because that is how much He loves us. In fact, even when we deliberately disobeyed and rebelled against God through sin, He sent His Son, Jesus, to die for our sins and redeem us. This was all done because of His great love for us (Romans 5:8). What does Psalm 139:13–17 say about how God values us?
